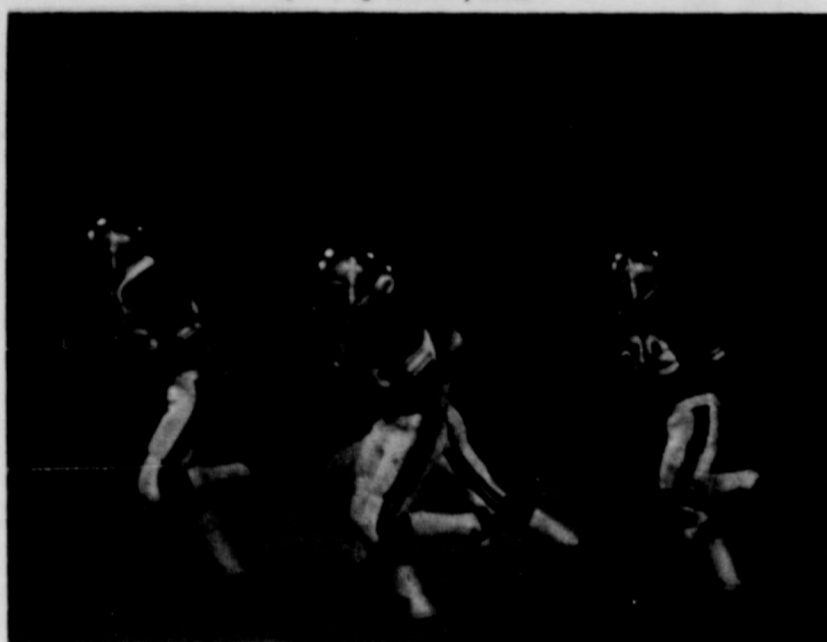
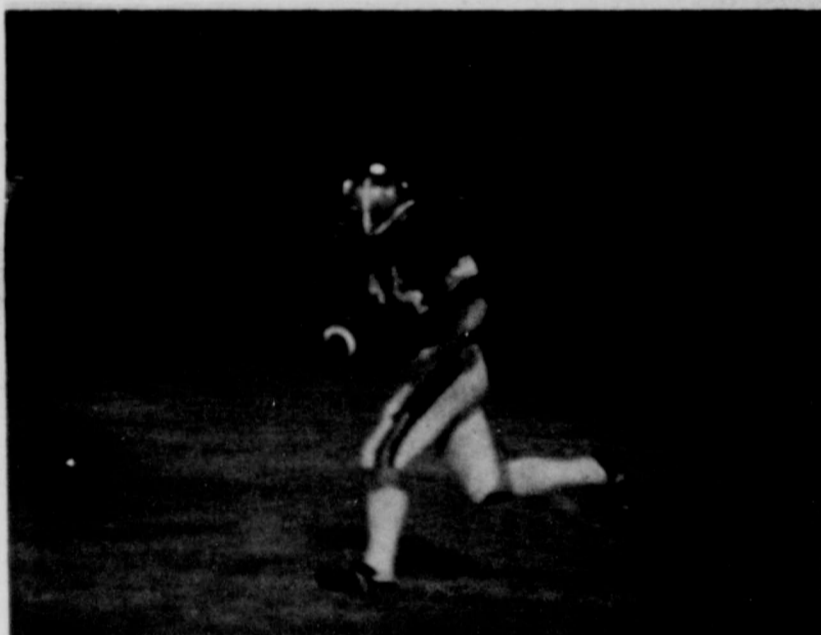


Junior Quarterback Wayne Riley getting ready to release the ball in Friday night's game against Floydada.

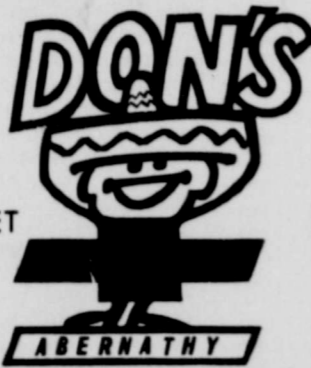

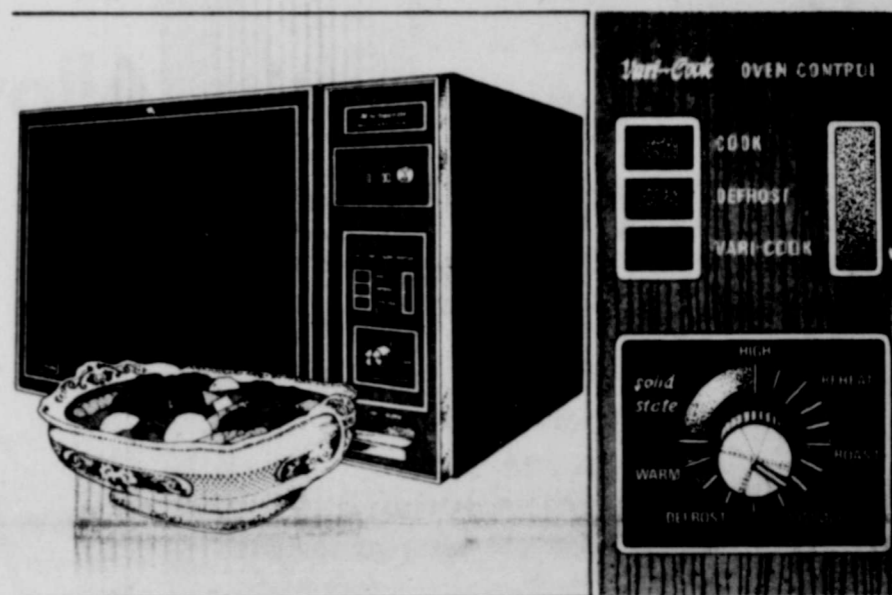
