## County's administration reflects changes

WINTERS - As Barry Hilliard will be succeeding Marilyn Egan as the new Runnels County Judge on the first day of 2011, several changes are already taking place in the County's administration. Last Tuesday, December 21, several decisions were made regarding staff members and the expenditure system.

The Commissioners Court regular meeting, held at the Commissioners Courtroom, included the resignation of the

Runnels County Emergency Management Coordinator. Jana Foster submitted her resignation effective on December 31, 2010. The resignation was accepted by the Commissioners.

Commissioners also agreed to evaluate and possibly change the current expenditure system. Currently the Commissioners Court members have one credit card account and another one is used for the rest of the county's employees.

In January, the Commissioners Court will

bring in a representative from the credit card company to evaluate the benefits of signing each authorized credit card holder with his/her own account.

Among other agenda items the Commissioners approved the payment of all current accounts and ratified payment of any account that had been pre-approved between court dates by members duly appointed by the Commissioners Court.

Commissioners approved unanimously official bonds of

Glenda Wood, Justice of the Peace, Precinct 1; James Ronald Presley, Commissioner Precinct 2, and Richard Hamilton, Justice of the Peace Precinct 2.

The Commissioners' Court approved the continuation of the bond for Natalie Lange, Assistant County Auditor, Blanket Crime Bonds for Glenda Wood, Justice of the Peace Precinct 1; Runnels County Sheriff's Office and the Runnels County Clerk's Office.

Bonds for Richard Strube, Commissioner Precinct 4, Eles Ocker, County Clerk, and

Tammy Burleson, District Clerk, had already been approved at the December 14 regular meeting.

The Commissioners Court will be posting in the agenda for the next regular meeting budget amendments to the 2010-2011 fiscal year.

Budget amendments are needed to cover the new Runnels County Aging Services Director, Kourtney Pierik. Pierik was hired at the December 14 Commissioners Court regular meeting, effective on December 15.

## New Fire Marshal appointed

Position filled after six months

WINTERS— After six months without a Fire Marshal the City of Winters approved this week, at the City Council Regular meeting, to appoint one of the officers with the Police Department as the new Winters Fire Marshal. The council appointed Paula Geyer for the position.

Officer Geyer passed her fire Marshal exam last week, and will be taking over the duties of the position left vacant on June of 2010.

Among other items the City Council also evaluated a report, presented by Sage Diller, eHT, on the status of the Water Treatment Plant. Update continues to be a work in progress and the Council authorized an extension for the construction works. It is expected that the plant will be ready by March of 2011.

The Council approved a contract change order No. 6 for the Winters WTP Rehab Project.

The City of Winters will also be evaluating the pump and water conditions on a property submitted to donation by Randall Underwood, in order to verify that the utilities can be used in the future. If everything is in order the property will become a new public park for the city.

Several changes were approved in the Housing Authority Directors, Joyce Green will be succeeding Bettye Pinkerton and Wilbur Layton succeeds Joyce Green. Marsha Smith, Philip Esquivel and Linda Dry will be succeeding themselves in the Board of

Alan Hollander, the new City Manager was appointed by the council as Emergency Management Coordinator for City of Winters. Hollander's was nominated by Winters Police Chief Nathan Johnson.

The City Council approved the Christmas holiday schedule. On Thursday, December 23, the City Hall will be closing at Noon.

The council also scheduled a meeting for Monday, January 24, 2011, to call for bids regarding USDA Rural Development project.

An agenda item regarding the Chamber of Commerce using Community Center was postponed until next council meeting. Also an item regarding signage for Winters.

The council meeting closed with the City Hall, Chief of Police, and Municipal Judge's monthly reports.

**Sex offenders can come from all segments of a society**

**High risk offenders - Part III**

As we continue our series, I will share some more pointers on how to protect children from high-risk offenders. The following is an abbreviated list of common characteristics identified by law enforcement around the country, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, and the Department of Justice.

**COMMON CHARACTERISTICS OF PEDOPHILES / CHILD SEX OFFENDERS**

Remember, sex offenders can come from all segments of a society. They can be adolescents, teenagers, adults or senior citizens. They can come from any racial, ethnic or religious background. They can be rich, poor, or middle class.

It is important to understand that certain behaviors are not always indicative of sexual offenses, but can be a sign of trouble and parents should be aware of these.

Some common warning signs can include an adult who does some of the following:

1. Insists on hugging, kissing, touching, wrestling or holding a child even if the child resists
2. Is too interested in a child's developing body, sexuality, dating habits, etc....
3. Seeks uninterrupted time alone with a child out of site from others
4. Spends more time with children than with people his/her own age, and more time doing activities involving children than activities involving adults
5. Offers to babysit children free of charge and/or takes them on overnight outings without another adult present

10. Talks with children about sexual fantasies, and seems unclear about what is O.K. to do and talk about with children

11. Encourages children to keep secrets

12. Looks at child pornography or images of partially clothed children on a consistent basis

13. Asks adult partners to dress or act like children or teens during sexual activity

14. Has a series of children who are "special friends"

15. Makes fun of children's body parts, and calls children sexually associated names

**HOW CAN A PARENT TELL IF THEIR CHILD IS BEING ABUSED?**

Both behavioral and physical signs may provide clues that a child is being sexually abused. Keep in mind, however, that many of these changes can also occur at other times of stress or trauma in a child's life, like a divorce or the death of a loved one or pet.

Some common behavioral warning signs can include actions such as the following:

1. Nightmares, fear of the dark, or other sleeping problems
2. Extreme fear of "monsters"
3. Loss of appetite, trouble eating or swallowing, or constant stomach aches and disturbances for no apparent reason
4. Sudden mood swings, such as rage, fear, anger, or withdrawal, or spacing out at odd times
5. Fear of certain people or places not formerly feared, or uncharacteristic behavior around a certain person, e.g., a talkative child becomes quiet and distant around a babysitter, family member, family friend, etc...
6. Regressive behavior, like a return to thumb sucking or re-occurring bed-wetting
7. Imitating sexual behavior with toys or other children
8. Using new words for body parts;
9. Refusing to talk about a "secret" the child shares with an adult or older child
10. Talking about a new, older friend
11. Suddenly having spending money

You as the parent are the best gauge of your child's behavior. Watch for suspicious or unusual behavior patterns that may indicate your child is struggling with a serious issue in their lives.

WINTERS - Nearly 70 years after an Air Force cadet came to Runnels County, to complete his education in the Fred Harmon Training Center, his picture and flight log were incorporated to the historical assets kept in Winters at the Rock Hotel museum.

Elwood "Woody" Bachelder was raised in Grand Rapids, Michigan, and enlisted in the Army for World War II. He applied and was accepted as a Cadet into the Air Force and was sent to West Texas to receive his air flight training. In 1941 Woody Bachelder came to Ballinger, to be trained at what is now known as the Bruce Field or Ballinger Airport.

Although Bachelder never lived in or re-visited Runnels County again, his daughter Starlyn, chose the city of Winters to be her and her husband's retirement home in November, 2009. After doing some research she

found that her father had been in Ballinger for the first portion of his training prior to having ever met and marrying his future wife. "We didn't realize my

father's history here, and my mother could not recall the name of the community and facility where my father first started his flight training," said Starlyn Smelker. Starlyn and her husband Richard lived in Dallas and chose Winters to retire unaware of the roots tying her father's past to this area.

The couple brought Starlyn's mother, Verna Marie (Hall) Bachelder, to live with them.

"We consider this the completing of a full circle, bringing my parents, their memories and their history back to Texas," said Starlyn about the picture of her father and his flight log being loaned to the museum.

Woody Bachelder's trip was hardly straight, after finishing his Primary training in Ballinger he was sent to Curtis Field, in Brady, Texas, to continue with his Basic phase of training. In 1942 the pilot married his wife of 36 years, Verna Marie Hall, who was raised in Brady. She had been working at Curtis Field, in the Officer's PX, where they first met each other. They married in Pampa, Texas, the next day after he completed his Advanced training, received his wings and was promoted to flying twin engine airplanes. He eventu-

ally piloted B26 Bombers. Bachelder was deployed to many places. His Air Force duties took him to fly over England, Japan, France, Africa and many other places, until his service with the Air Force was fulfilled achieving the rank of First Lieutenant at the end of WWII.

Woody Bachelder went back to Michigan, where his parents owned and operated a large trucking company. He accepted a position as an Airport Manager in Hastings, Michigan, and later became the owner of an Appliance and Sporting Goods store there. He passed away in 1978 without ever coming back to Runnels County, Texas.

In November of 2009, the Smelkers chose Winters as their retirement home. Richard, an Industrial Designer originally for the automotive industry, had been relocated by his company to work in the Aerospace industry in Dallas prior to coming to Winters. Neither of them or Starlyn's mother, Verna Marie, had any idea that they would be moving into this part of the country in which her father had been part of this area's history so many years ago.

When they found out that Starlyn's father had received his first flight training in the area, they considered it was time to complete the circle.

Last Monday, December 13, Starlyn Smelker and her mother, Verna Marie Bachelder, submitted Woody's photo and flight log to be on display in the Veteran's Room, in the historical Rock Hotel. The ceremony was held during the Veterans of Foreign Wars night hosting the second annual "Magic Moments with Trees."

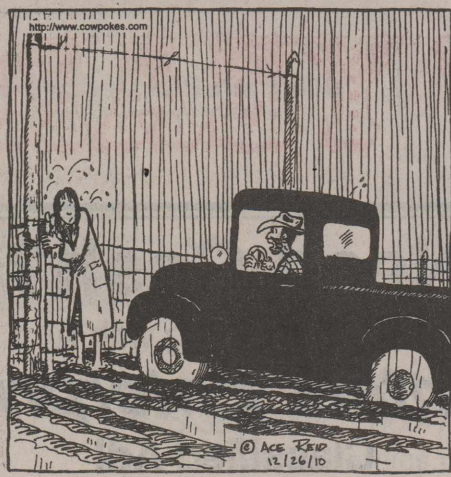

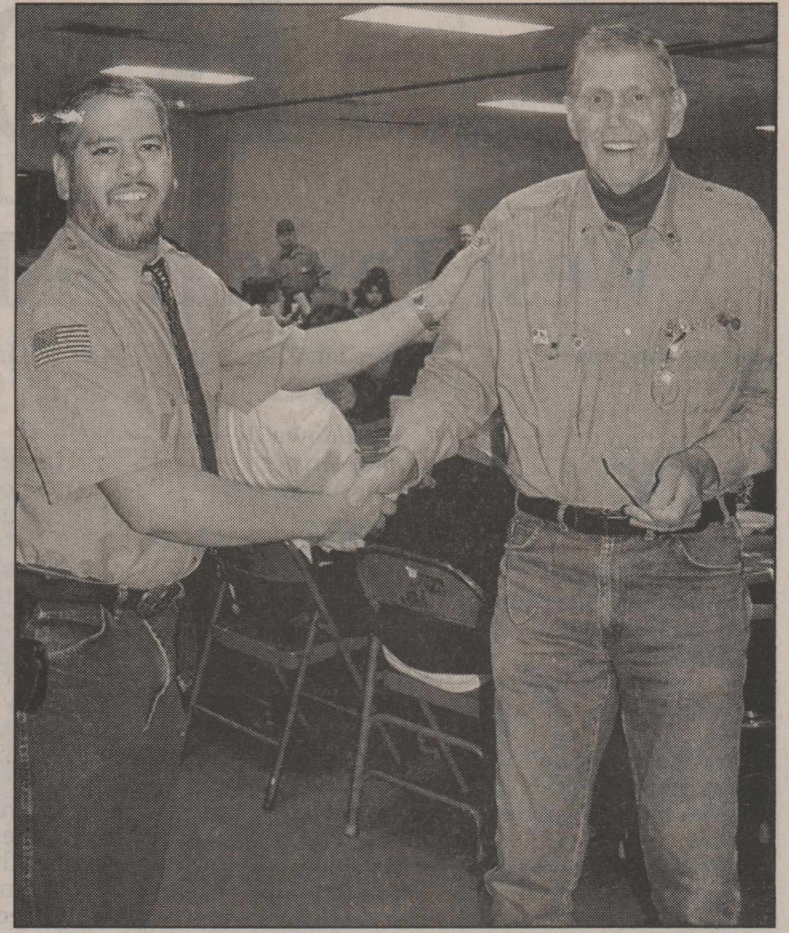

## Tax bill boosts farming

WASHINGTON - The tax bill signed last week by President Obama will help families, businesses, farmers and ranchers, and represents a huge aid for America's economy, said Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack.

"Members of both parties came together to get this done and now middle-class families in rural America and throughout the country no longer have to worry about a massive tax hike next year. As President Obama signs this important legislation, he is bolstering efforts underway to rebuild and revitalize rural America and promoting job creation in rural communities."

The tax package signed last Friday by President Obama reauthorizes ethanol tax credits and reinstates the biodiesel tax credit.

"Ethanol and biodiesel production is critical to continuing the growth of our domestic fuel industry that is reducing our dependence on foreign oil while creating green jobs from renewable sources and adding opportunities for people in rural communities throughout the country."

"The tax package will also extend tax incentives through 2011 for farmers, ranchers and forest owners who voluntarily conserve their lands through donation of a conservation easement. Providing this tax incentive will increase conservation of our working lands and, in so doing, support our rural economy."

## Don't Drink & Drive

BALLINGER LEDGER  
STAFF REPORT

According to traffic safety experts, the daily death toll from drunk driving crashes during the Christmas and New Year's holiday period is significantly more than during the rest of the year. In December of 2008 alone in Texas, more than 39,000 traffic crashes injured 20,000 people and killed 313 more. Alcohol was involved in 85 of the December 2008 fatalities. For the calendar year of 2008, 3,468 fatal crashes occurred statewide. Alcohol was related in 975 of the 3,468 fatalities making alcohol a factor in 28% of all fatal crashes. (Data based on an analysis of Texas Crash Reporting Information Systems [CRIS] data since 2003.)

This year, The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Santa's reindeer have an important message for Texas drivers—don't drive if you're tipsy, buzzed or "Blitzen"; call a cab or get a sober ride home instead. For the thirteenth consecutive year, TxDOT is sponsoring the popular holiday-themed public education campaign to remind Texans not to get behind the wheel if they've been drinking. The paid media campaign will run from December 21 through January 1, targeting English and Spanish-speaking motorists between ages 25 and 54.

Bail, fines, court costs, attorney fees, insurance rate hikes, surcharges to keep the driver's license and probation costs aren't on anyone's wish list. A DWI arrest and conviction can cost between \$5,000 and \$24,000 or more. Even a little holiday cheer can impair your driving. Plan ahead if you plan to drink alcohol.

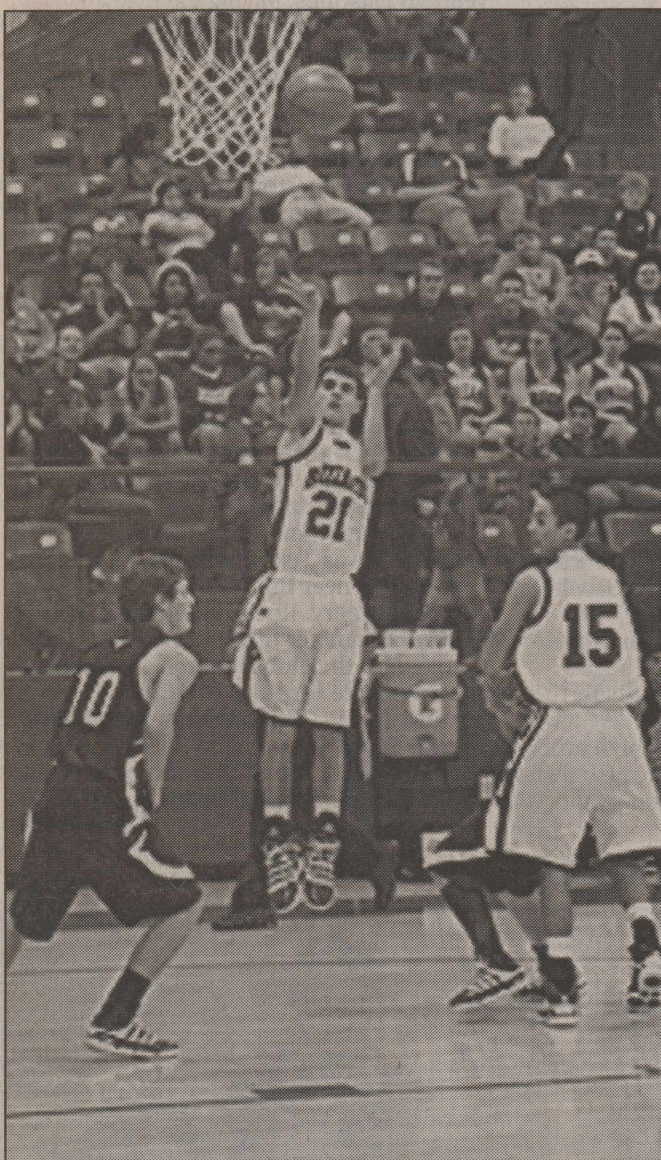

Last day of the exhibition will be featuring Richard and Starlyn Smelker, new residents of Winters, who have been singing

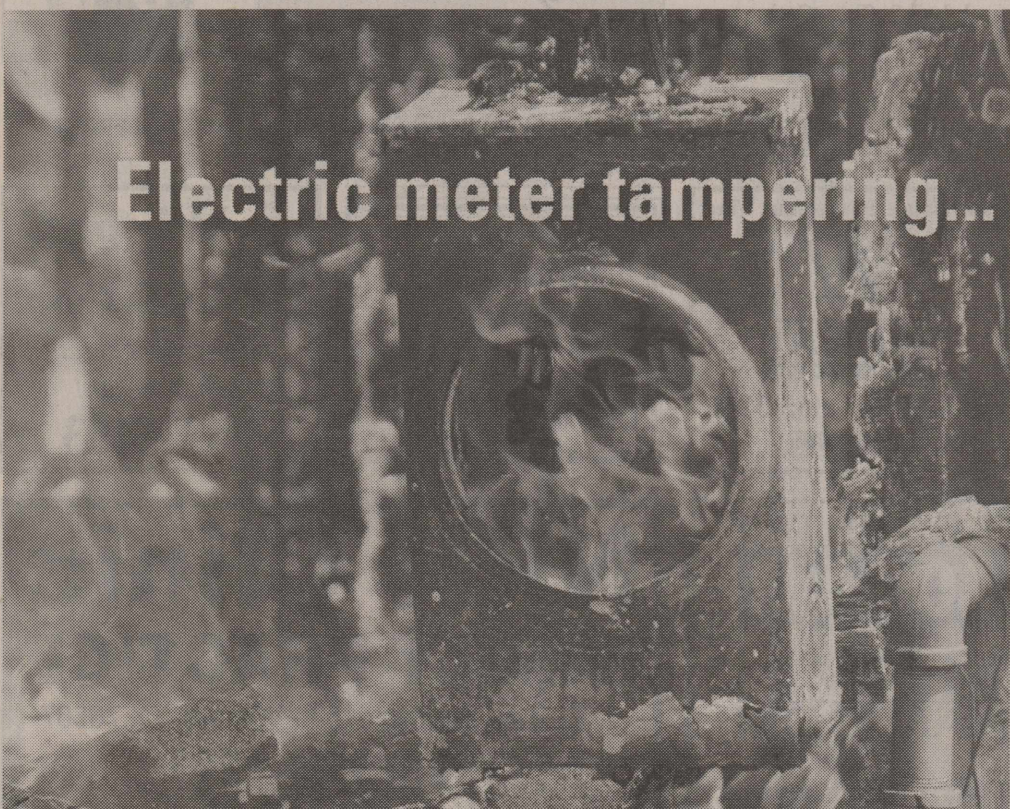
together since their Junior High School years in Hastings, Michigan.

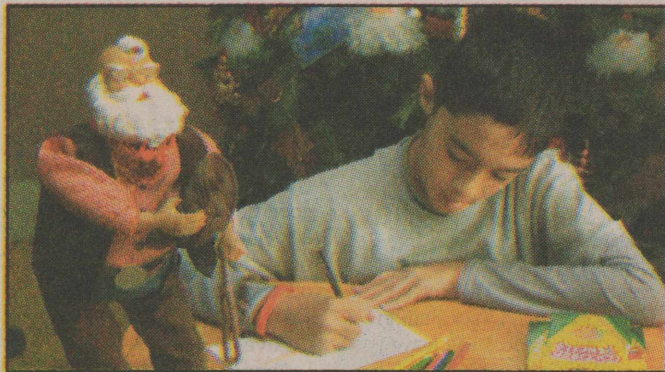
