A renewed appreciation for existing community assets can be the first step in increasing a community's economic options.

However, asset identification, evaluation and development are especially difficult for most small communities, because leaders and residents alike are so familiar with all aspects of their communities. This familiarity can create a circumstance that impedes the recognition and enjoyment of the people, places and things that are community assets. This hindrance to recognizing

assets, frequently also inhibits thoughts of how community assets can be developed and

promoted to increase community vitality.

Residents and leaders are reevaluating existing community assets to uncover new opportunities for sustainable economic growth. One such effort is the Painted Screens Pilgrimage in Baltimore, Maryland. The modern walking and driving tour all started in 1913, as a way of obscuring the view inside a single business without hindering airflow. The effort was noticed and appreciated by other community residents who followed suit and painted beautiful art onto the screens of their own windows. Over time, many Baltimore window screens were painted, and the practice became a local tradition. Through the cooperative efforts of the Painted Screen Society of Baltimore and community leadership, the Painted Screens Pilgrimage has become a popular attraction for art-loving Baltimore visitors. This simple effort of painting artwork on window screens provides residents with a fun civic activity that promotes interaction among neighbors. It also provides residents with a way to be active participants in a cultural aspect of their community. Therefore, the tradition adds to the quality of life for residents and provides

the community with a unique cultural feature. All the while, their unified efforts provides the entire community with an asset that brings visitors to their community and boosts the local economy. One other such example is the New Archangel Dancers of Sitka, Alaska. This unique performance group was established in the 1950s, by eight Sitka women who wanted to promote and encourage tourism in Sitka. Their story is particularly appropriate when considering both forms of asset appreciation. These eight individuals recognized Alaska's Russian History and understood that unique historic fact was a local

asset. They also understood that tourists on North West Passage cruises who were arriving in Sitka throughout tourist season were a local asset. Through interaction with these tourists, they knew all were in search of unique experiences while visiting Sitka. Furthermore, they believed they could capitalize on all those local assets, because they knew they could learn Russian dances and sew authentic Russian dance attire – these women understood their own skills and abilities were assets. So, eight women decided to capitalize on all those local assets through the sharing of Russian folk dance and song. When the group was first established, these women knew nothing about Russian dance and had no authentic Russian dance attire. Also, none had Russian lineage or were professional dancers. Now, 47 years later, the

troupe has been so successful they have built their own performance hall and have performed around the world. The large performance hall their efforts paid for, serves the community of Sitka and its residents throughout the year. The point of sharing Baltimore's Painted Screen effort and Sitka's New Archangel Dancers is to inspire this question: What local assets can receive new appreciation to bring appreciation to local economies?
