MUSTIN — Owners of advertising signs - from giant bill-board to small signs hanging on fences - along Interstate, U. S. and State highways, have until Dec. 31 to apply for permits under the new Texas Highway Beautification Act.

The act requires that no sign can be erected within 660 feet of an interstate or federal-aid primary highway without a special \$25 outdoor advertising license. An additional \$5 permit is also required for each sign. A license and permit will not be required for (1) directional and other official signs owned by a political subdivision, governmental agency or non-profit historical, service or religious organization, (2) on-premise signs or (3) utility




