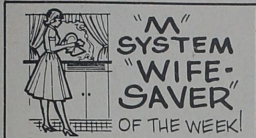

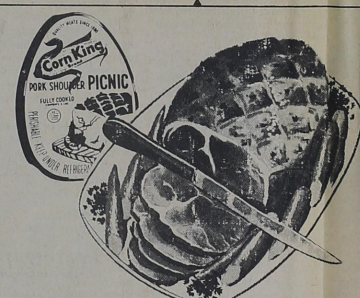

How Munday Looked 18 Years Ago Last Sunday!



Munday received only a brief shower last Sunday, the 18th anniversary of the "Big Flood" which occurred here and shown in these photos. This was June 13, 1930. Citizens milked their cows on front porches, boats were used in the streets, water stood ten inches deep in the Times office, no lives were lost. Munday's flood came as a result of heavy rains in Munday and Thorp. The above scene was repeated in a lesser degree in 1940.

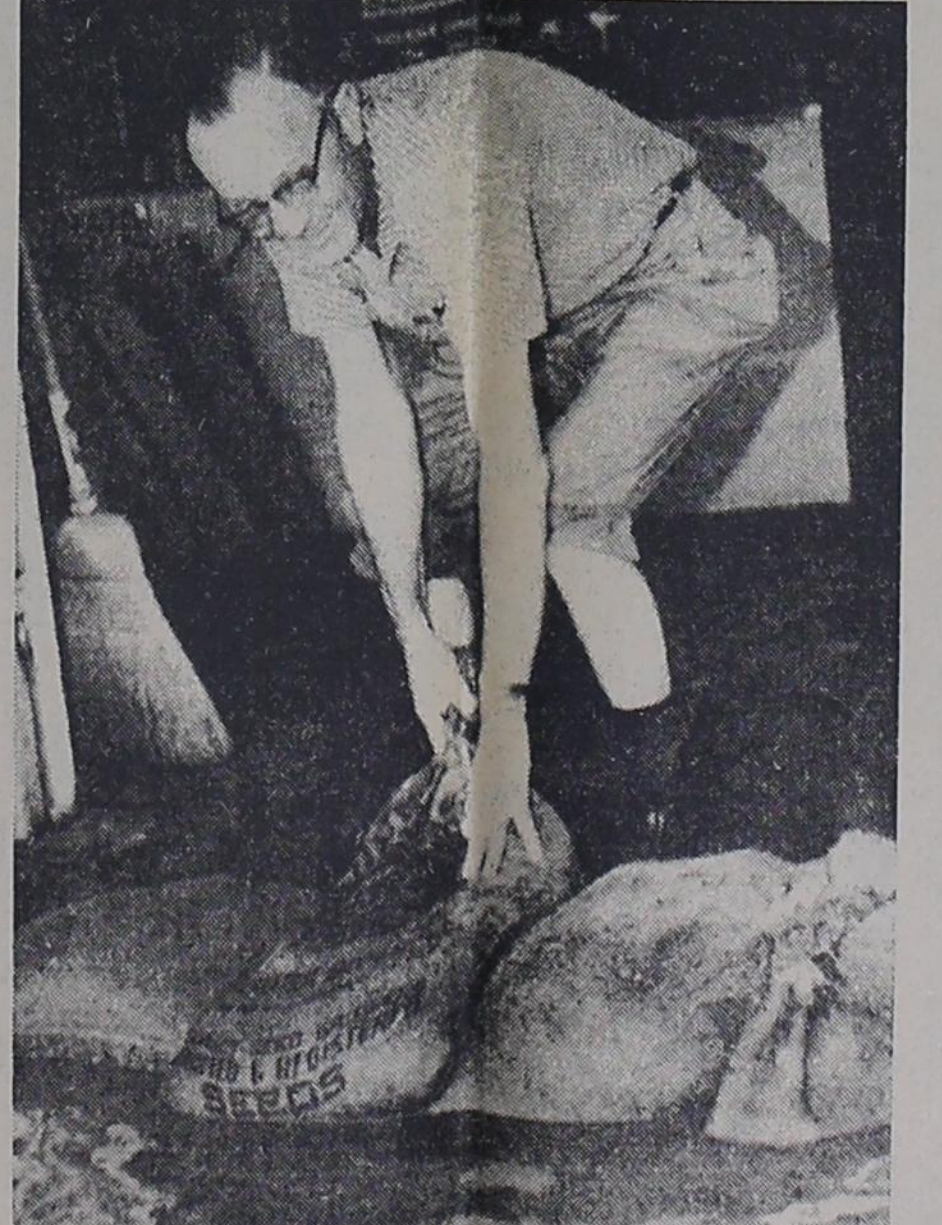
