City of Clyde gets Facelifting in 1973

CLYDE- As we come to the end of the 1973 year we tend to look back and see what progress and improvements we have made. We look at our City of Clyde and find many improvements since the beginning of the

First we saw the remodeling of Bailey Funeral Home, and the addition of a Chapel to the home. The white stone building with brown trim is truly an asset to our town. The Baileys have been in business here since June 1947.

Later the P. C. Steen Company moved to the building just south of them. However, before their move many improvements of painting and remodeling were made. The P. C. Steen Company has been located in Clyde for 59 years, in the same location, and has been operated by the Steen family all this time. They will celebrate 60 years in business in April 1974.

Next we watched Ray Falk's BBB Drug Completely remodeled, inside and out, with the addition of a gift galory to the business. Repairs began on the inside and were completed with a beautiful new colonial front with small picture windows of display. Ray and Faye Falk have owned and operated BBB Drug for the past 31/2 years. This business is truly an added attraction to Clyde.

Smith's Flower Shop has recently moved to a new location on Oak Street in Clyde to us old timers this was the former Tandy Walker Drug Store. The Smith's completely remodeled the building, with picture windows and a brick front, and made many improvements inside, and have included zift items to their many floral crang ments. The Smiths forerly had the business in their iome, and have owned and operated the business for 10

Harber Grocery on South 1st street, formerly Pyeatts Grocery had made a number of changes on the inside enlarging the store and re-arranging, and adding a number of facilities to the store

Joel Holmes moved his Real Estate office west to the end of the block, just down from his old office. He too, has made a number of improvements to the

building. Now in progress is the re modeling of the old locker plant on Oak Street, this is being done by Gaston Swofford, attorney, and the Clyde Insurance Agency. Plans are for officers where the locker formerly was, and the Insurance Agency will

remain where it is but will be remodeled, they will be joined together when completed. This

The Clyde Fire Department now has 6 active units, including 1 rescue unit, and 1 unit in reserve. The Department has 23 active members and 4 exempt members. Exempt members are those having served 10 years or reached the age of 50, however they still help out when

Members are presently constructing No. 2 station located at South 1st & Stephens or FM 18. This 30x60 structure when completed will house one booster and 1 or 2 rural fire fighting units. This building is being built separate from the No. 1 Station so Clyde will have fire stations and equipment on both sides of the railroad track.

The Fire Department is equipped with two-way radios and are in constant contact with the Department of Public Safety, so if more help is needed from other towns it can be quickly called for. The City of Clyde has helped purchase the radios and partially financing the new station. All labor done on the new structure is being volunteered by the local firemen. They have spent many hours of their free time in

helping with this building.



WHEREAS, he was active in civic work, having served

as President of the Baird United Fund; as a member of the local committee of the Salvation Army; as Secretary-Treasurer for seven years of the Baird Lions Club; as President of the Callahan County Luncheon Club, and as Chairman of the Christmas Bonus Plan sponsored annually by local merchants, and

WHEREAS, he was a longtime member of the Baptist Church, and

WHEREAS, he was manager of the Baird Housing Authority, and as such was faithful in looking to the welfare of the occupants of the houses, providing transportation and other aid when needed, and

WHEREAS, his life exemplified true devotion to the best interests of our community, and







A combination of many things must be considered when speaking of ways to improve the air we breathe, the water we drink, and also increase the supply of food and fiber for our economy, Ringhoffer said. One conservation practice

that improves the local environment is proper management of both native grasslands and improved pastures. By managing the grazing load on native and improved pastures, farmers and ranchers have greatly reduced the amount of soil loss that would otherwise pollute our streams and lakes. The rancher is not only able to produce more beef at a low price to the housewife, but proper grazing on grasslands also improves the recreational activities on the local lakes. Deer and turkey are healthy and also in good condition this year, which is attributed to the proper use of rangelands that has been given by local ranchers.







From a famous peem, probably one of the most cherished and well remembered in all of the English language

Written almost 150 years ago by Clement Clark Moore, this poem helped create one of the great legendary figures of all time, the "plump and jolly old elf," Santa Claus (who up to that time was depicted as rather a gaunt and somber St. Nicholas whose living prototype had been an obscure ecclesiastic of the Fourth Century).

There is no substantiated version of how Dr. Moore got his idea for this image, so different from most of those prevailing.

The actual image of Santa Claus, or St. Nicholas as Moore called him in the first version, may have come from the moon-silhouetted face of his handyman.

Legend holds that it was on a sleigh ride over the now packed New York streets of 1822 as he and his handyman, Peter, went from the estate to Greenwich Village to deliver Christmas presents.

The famous lines were set down by Moore at a writing desk in his home located on a 90-acre tract in a New York City area still known as Chelsea, down on the lower West Side where the wholesale flower market now stands.



At the time. Moore was a professor of Oriental languages in the General Theological Seminary in New

According to tradition, Moore read the poem to his children that Christmas Eve, although it seems more likely that the chil-


Christmas . . . what memories it evokes. What joys it promises. In all of the recorded history of man, what other holiday com-

"In the Twelve Days of

Christmas My true love said to me . . . "

The verses are among the most popular of the Season. They date back to 567 A.D., when the Church proclaimed the period of twelve days, from the Nativity to Epiphany, a period of celebration

It is in fact the big holiday of the year in most countries where Christianity exists.

In medieval England festivities ranged the calendar, day and night. There were jousts, with knights in armor pennants flying, and lances flashing in the sun, and wimpled ladies watching from the stands

There was banqueting, caroling and also "mum-ming" which originally was pantomime dance performed by groups who were both costumed and masked. Minstrels and jugglers plied their arts, made music and

In the Middle Ages, when

few people could read, and entertainment as we know it did not exist, a minstrel was of necessity a manytalented fellow. One of these, in listing his accomplishments, after noting the many instruments he can play, says: "I can sing a song well and make tales and fables. I can tell a story against any man, I can make love verses to please young ladies, and can play the gallant to them if necessary. Then I can throw knives into the air and catch them without cutting my fingers. I can do dodges with a string most extraordinary and amusing. I can balance chairs and make tables dance. I can throw a somersault and walk on my

This English minstrel, of course, had his counterpart in Europe, where the twelve days were celebrated too, with feasting, pageantry, and song.

In England some of the 'pretty devices' preceding the banquets in the big halls on Twelfth Day are unbelievable-sounding confections which included castles with cannons and ships with guns which, at the proper moment, were fired against each other in semblance of a rousing battle.






