The workshop provides an excellent opportunity for young people interested in art.

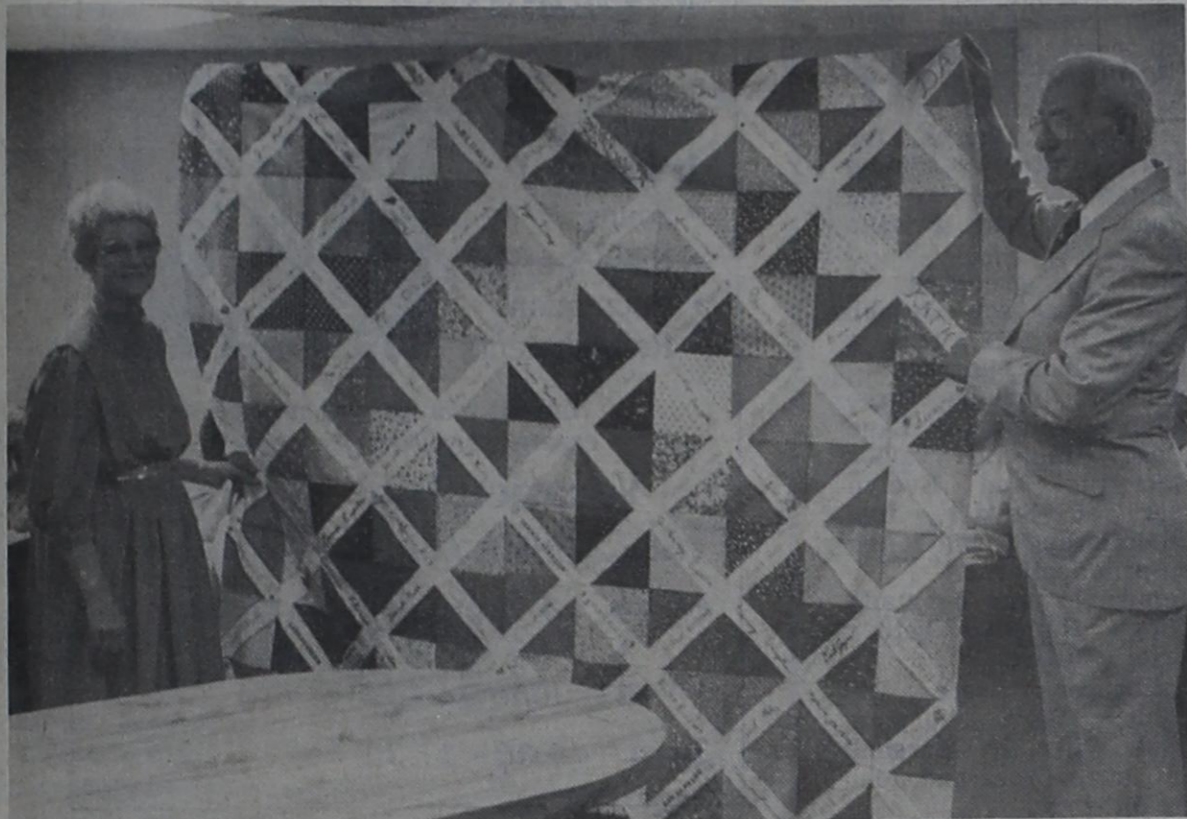

Summer Recreation Set

Registration for the Summer Recreation program will be held Saturday, June 1 at the Junior High gym from 9 a.m. to noon.

The program is open to youth entering the second grade through those entering the eighth grade.

The program starts Monday, June 3 and continues to June 27.

"We need a lot of youth to participate in the program," director Darrell Radle comments, "if we are to continue offering this in the future."

Radle's concern centers around the possibility of funding problems next year as county commissioners and city council members have expressed doubts about the funding.

"Last year there 125 youth who took part in the

program," Radle explains.

The program is funded jointly by the city and county with a total budget this year of \$3,600.

Included in the activities will be gymnastics, tennis, crafts, archery, track, games, aerobics, girls' softball, swimming, weight training and football.

Lot Values Increased

"Today's laws demand that all property be reappraised every five years and be taxed at market value," Westfall adds.

"The State Property Tax Board hires independent appraisers to check the value of all property and make a report which is available to all interested parties," she continued.

"In 1983 the vacant lots in the City of Post assessed value on the tax rolls was reported at only 74 percent of market value by the State Property Tax Board.

"Since then the demand has been greater and the

market price has increased.

"Taking all this into consideration, the Garza County Appraisal District has been forced to reappraise the land in the City of Post," Westfall said.

Residential lots in Post are being assessed higher property values, as the result of a review by the Garza County Appraisal District, resulting in dramatic increases for property owners.

Property owners may protest the new appraisals at an Appraisal Review Board meeting to be held

June 5 beginning at 9 a.m. at the Courthouse.

The higher appraisals reflect market values of residential lots, according to Appraisal District director Jean Westfall.

"Anyone trying to buy a houseplace in Post knows there is just not much land to be bought," Westfall explains.

"What there is to be bought is selling from \$50 a front foot to \$75 a front foot or from \$2,000 to \$3,000 a lot.

"This can be figured out to be approximately \$14,300 an acre to \$21,450 an acre.
