1989 Cotton Yields Disappointing Compared with '88 Bumper Crop

"This is not the worst year in 10 years," a representative of Plains Cotton Growers, Inc. said. "In 1982, 1983 and 1986 we had less bales ginned and lower yields per harvested acre than it looks like we have from this crop."

But with two bumper years back-to-back with billion dollar crops, the 1989 cotton crop for the area looks disappointingly small by comparison.

With ginning activities complete in Garza County, totals are much lower than those reported for 1988.

Graham Co-op Gin, finished the season with a total of 4,192 bales, compared to a 1988 total of 9,706.

With ginning "about finished" at the Hackberry Co-Op Gin, Morton Smith reports that 10,856 bales were ginned. The Hackberry total for 1988 was 17,300 bales.

The Southland Gin has "one more day to go" and will end the season with a total of "about 1,800," compared with 4,022 bales in '88.

The weather has probably been, yet again, the major factor in the size of the crop. Drought conditions through May over the area meant that much of the planted acres never got out of the ground. Then hailstorms and washing rains in July took their toll, especially in surrounding counties, reducing harvestable acres to maybe less than two million. The early, October freeze drastically reduced yields on what remained of the crop, especially the large percentage of late-

planted June cotton.

The size of the area cotton crop has been guessed at many times during the year. Final figures are still not available but estimates vary from 1.3 to 1.4 million bales.

Markets do not show much movement of the new crop as yet.

Many producers may be waiting for the new tax year to sell their equities in this year's production. Prices do not seem to be holding up to the expectations that many have, but supply and demand should determine over time what the 1989 production will eventually bring.

City Sales Tax Rebates Climb Again

Sales tax rebates for the City of Post continued to climb with the recent receipt of a December payment from the State Comptroller's office in the amount of \$13,146.79.

The December 1989 check is a 19.26 percent increase over December 1988's rebate of \$11,023.57.

However, overall totals for the year leave Post with a 4.14 percent decrease in total yearly payments. 1989 payments to date total \$164,201.73, as compared to 1988's payments of \$171,292.68.

Rebates received by area cities include:

Slaton, \$13,369.11, a 7.81 percent increase over December 1988's \$12,400.36. 1989 payments to date, \$204,989.18, a 2.94 percent decrease from 1988's total of \$211,194.71.

Tahoka, \$4,782.77, a 44.42 percent decrease from December 1988's \$3,311.75. 1989 payments to date, \$64,375.83, a 0.52 percent increase over 1988's total of \$64,042.48.

Spur, \$2,692.03, a 60.69 percent increase over December 1988's \$1,675.32. 1989 payments to date, \$18,499.15, a 62.90 percent decrease from 1988's \$49,858.13.

Crosbyton, \$4,113.36, a 15.98 percent increase over December 1988's \$3,546.54. 1989 payments to date, \$53,133.31, a decrease of

Theatre's December Production Delights Capacity Audiences

The Garza Theatre delivered an early Christmas present to area audiences last week as cast and crew presented the fast-paced farce "See How They Run," by Philip King, to FCO (folding chairs only) crowds.

The comedy classic involving cases of mistaken identity and "which one's the vicar," with a little revolution thrown in for good measure, was set in a post-World War II English vicarage and featured outstanding comedy performances by an ensemble cast put through their funny paces by director Will McCrary.

Turning the on-stage confusion into comedy and supplying the laughs for four appreciative audiences were Christy Morris as 'Ida,' the cockney maid with one eye on the vicarage and the other on the men who visit there; Linda Ellis as 'Miss Skillon,' a slightly inebriated spinster who winds up in the closet; Charles Somerville and Jane Prince Jones as the "real" vicar and his wife, 'The Reverend Lionel and Penelope Toop,' newcomer Jon Steele of Lubbock as an old friend from Penelope's past; Patrick

Connor as an escaped Russian revolutionary;

Mike Toombs, returning to the Garza stage after a long absence, as 'The Reverend Arthur Humphrey,' another newcomer and another cockney, Mark McKenzie as the local constabulary 'Sergeant Towers,' and director McCrary as 'The Bishop of Lax.'

Ablly assisting the on-stage crew was the backstage staff: Troy Timms, stage manager; Jeffrey Redman, assistant stage manager; Marshall Clements, property mas-

ter; Danny Leach, lighting operator; and Shane Horton, sound operator.

Watching this well-acted, well-staged, well-directed performance, a viewer can see why the fame of the Garza Theatre is growing and why capacity crowds are flocking to Post for each Garza presentation.

The next Garza Theatre production, "The Cradle Song" by G.M. Sierra, will give theatre-goers two extra opportunities to sample local acting talent, with performances scheduled for February 1-4 and February 9 and 10.

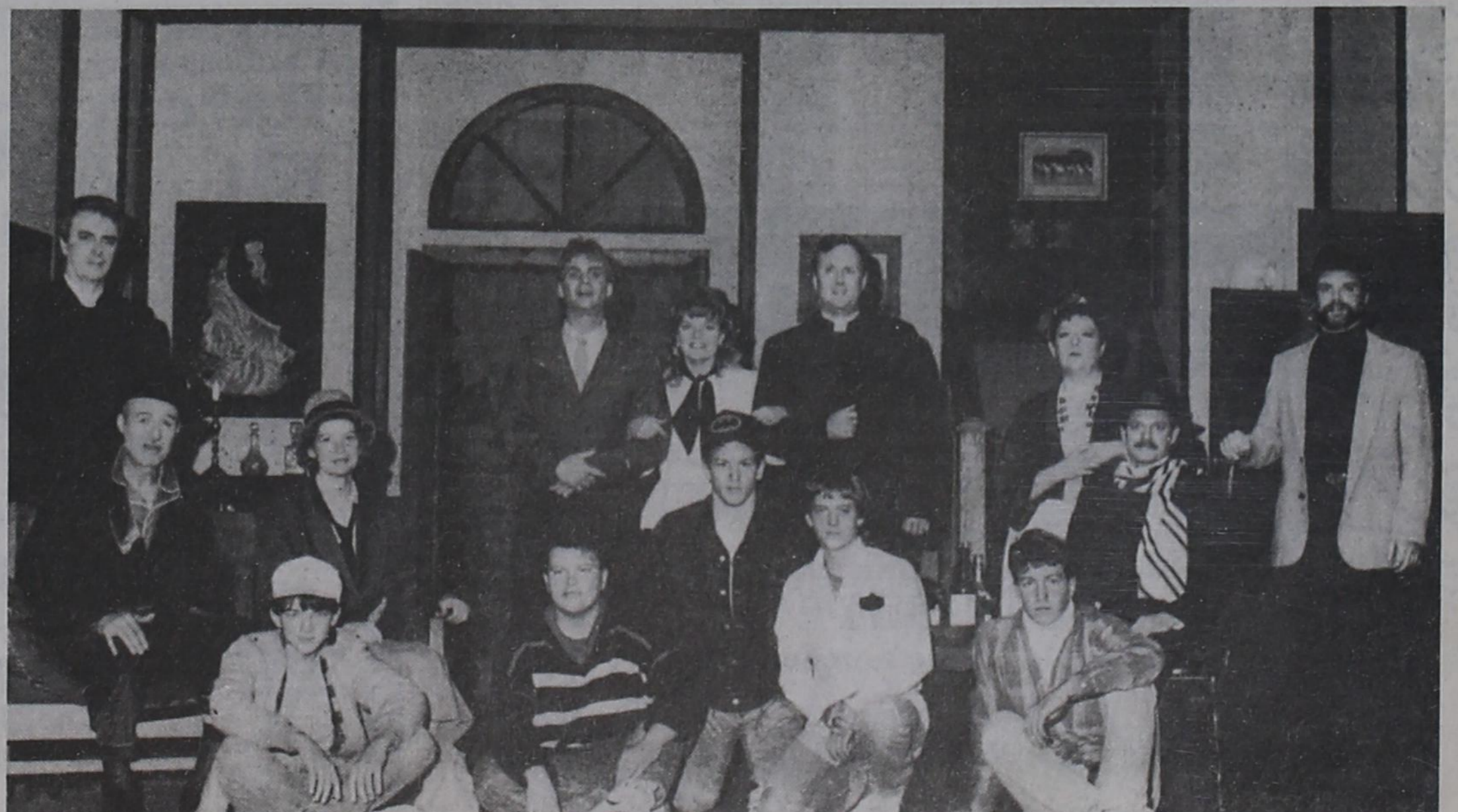
Garza County Commissioners' Court will move its regular fourth Monday of the month meeting to Friday, December 22 at 10 a.m.

On December 4, 1989, Bill Aten announced his candidacy for Garza County Commissioner, Precinct 2. Aten, the son of Ted and Eddie Aten, was raised in Garza County and has been actively engaged in farming and ranching here since 1974. In 1979, he married Donna Aten, currently a teacher in the Garza County school system. The couple has a son, Ross, who is six years old. Commenting on the county, Aten said, "Garza County has had some economically hard times in the past, but at least high taxes have not been a major concern, unlike many other Texas counties. Garza County has been fortunate for the last 20 years to have a Commissioners' Court that has put the problem of taxes and its burden on the taxpayer as its number one priority and has still kept the county progressing in a manner that the taxpayer can afford. "Since the tax valuation has

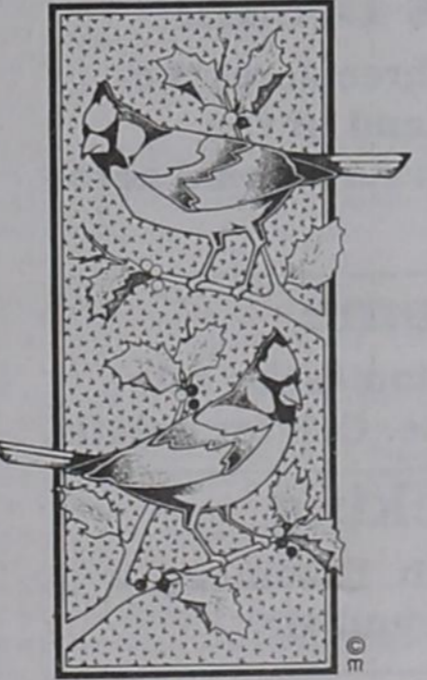

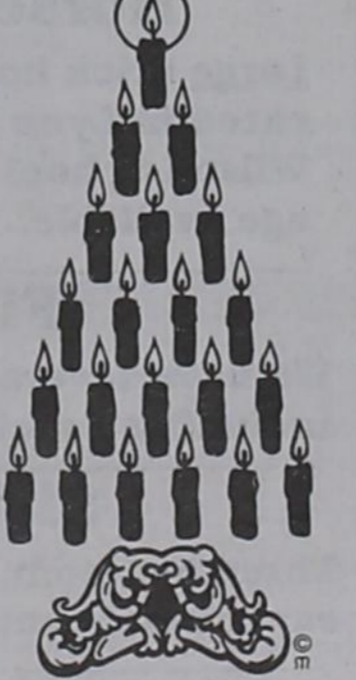

Ralls, \$3,982.46, a 7.73 percent increase over December 1988's \$3,696.72. 1989 payments to date, \$54,694.58, a decrease of 2.34 percent from 1988's \$56,007.31.

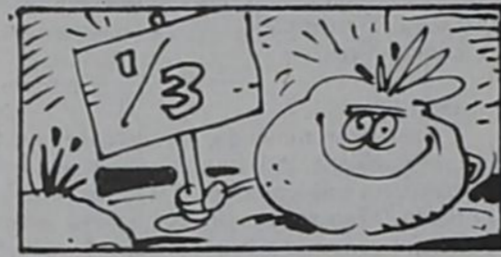
Sales tax rebates to Texas cities in 1989 topped \$1 billion for the first time in the state's history, according to the State Comptroller's office.

"People are spending more money and that means more tax dollars are going back to communities for fire fighting, police protection and safe road," Bob Bullock, State Comptroller, said.

This year's total payments to cities reached \$1.04 billion, nine percent more than last year's total of \$956 million. Payments to cities for the month of December totaled \$72 million, over 13 percent more than last December's payments of \$64 million.

This month's checks to cities and counties reflect taxes collected in October by businesses that file monthly returns.

Merchants collect the state and local sales tax and send it to the Comptroller's office with their tax returns. The state keeps its six percent share and returns the local sales taxes each month to local governments. Cities and counties may levy a combined tax of up to two percent above the state's sales tax.

New Policy for Play-Offs

(Continued from Page 1)

The proposed change of policy in allowing three teams to advance to the state play-offs instead of the current two will be forwarded to the Texas State Board of Education for review.

If adopted, three teams in each 5A district in the state would advance to the play-offs with the two largest schools entering a "Big School" 64-team bracket, with the higher-place finisher of the two representing the district as the number one seed. Play-offs would proceed with the first place team in a district playing the second place team in bidistrict. Two schools from the same district continuing to win would not meet until the quarterfinal rounds. Six rounds of play-offs would yield a "Big School State Champion."

The school with the smallest enrollment of the three top finishers would go into a 32-team 5A bracket, where district 1 plays district 2, 3 plays 4, etc. There would be five rounds of play-offs; bi-district, regional, quarterfinals, semifinals and finals, the winner being named the state 5A champion.
