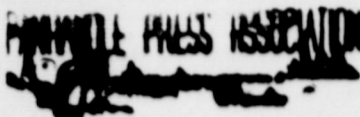

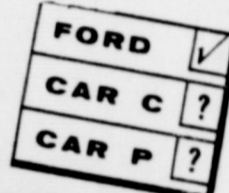

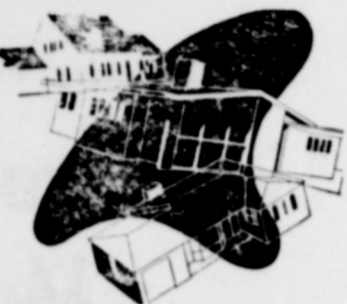

Parrot Fever . . . J. V. Irons first identified turkeys with the disease after an outbreak in 1948 at Giddings. Since then 2 more outbreaks have occurred among poultry dressers in Giddings and one among employees of a plant in El Campo.

Ornithosis has a flu-like onset with severe headaches and body pains. There were 7 deaths in the three Giddings outbreaks. The virus of ornithosis is found in the droppings and viscera of infected birds, especially in kidneys, liver, lungs and spleen. Droppings are dangerous because virus can be wafted into the air when droppings dry out. Handling infected viscera, either in packing plant or kitchen, exposes handlers to infection. The cooked flesh of turkeys is not dangerous.
