**THE MAN WHO TALKED TO HIS SOUL**

"The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully: and he reasoned within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have not where to bestow my fruits? He had doubtless expected several years at least in which to enjoy the fruits of his labors and to become a Christian, but God said unto him, Thou foolish one, this night is thy soul required of thee; and the things which thou hast prepared, whose shall they be? SO IS HE THAT LAYETH UP TREASURE FOR HIMSELF, AND IS NOT RICH TOWARD GOD!

anniversary of the PTA. This great organization was founded on Feb. 17th, 1897 in Washington, D. C. by Mrs. Alice McLellan Birney and Mrs. Phoebe Apperson Hearst. Parenthood was challenged to fulfill its duty of rearing not merely the children of a household and pupils in a school but citizens of a community, equipped in body, mind and spirit to perform a duty in the building of a nation. More than ten million members, both men and women, have accepted this plan.

Mrs. David Mears was the originator of the Founders Day Program and the purpose is to honor the Founders. A silver offering of voluntary contributions of the members is usually given to be used toward extending the parent-teacher movement.

Mrs. Smith had a most impressive and worthwhile program. The program was presented in the form of "This Is Your Life" with Mrs. John Stephens representing the Parent Teacher Association.

Mrs. Stephens told of the meaning of the oak tree which is the National PTA emblem. Mrs. Stephens is the president of the Borden County PTA.

A short summary of what the National PTA has accomplished from 1897 thru 1957 was presented by Mesdames Ben Kelly, John Dennis, C. C. Nunnally, Bill Riddle and A. M. Anderson. Under the direction of Miss Helen Curda, Borden County Music teacher, the Junior High Choral Club sang songs which were popular at that time.

Mrs. Prentiss Scott, Plains PTA president, told of a few of the many projects the association had carried out with Mrs. Garland Doyle telling of the Borden County PTA's projects. Mrs. Woodard gave a talk on Parent-Teacher work with the conclusion of the presentation of the PTA pin to Mrs. Scott and the bar to Mrs. Stephens. Mrs. Stephens then presented to Mrs. Woodard in behalf of the two associations a yellow carnation corsage with the number "60" in blue on the carnations. The ribbons and trimmings of the corsage of blue and gold carried out the colors of the PTA — blue and gold.

The climax of the program was most impressive with the candle lighting ceremony. Mesdames Dee Burrus, Vernie Barr and Miss Doris Steadman lighted the candles representing the church, the community and the school.

Lester Hollis, principal, gave the benediction. The ladies, attired in their 19th century dresses, served refreshments of yellow punch and yellow-tooped white cake from a most attractive table.

The centerpiece consisted of an ornament with the large number "60" in light blue in the center. The base of the ornament was dark blue with a yellow carnation and bow adorning either side of the "60". Gold oak leaves formed an arch at the back and over the "60". A display of the PTA objects was displayed in the background.

About 60 members and guests were present. Mrs. Clarence Cain, mother of Mrs. Woodard, and Mrs. Puckett, president of the Gay Hill PTA, were among the guests.

**PROPER CARE IN FLYING KITES IS URGED**

The Texas Electric Service Co. today appealed to parents to caution their children about flying kites near electric wires.

"The windy season brings kite flying time and this traditional sport is one that is lots of fun for children if it is done safely," Jimmy Lemons, Texas Electric Service Co. manager, pointed out. "Many youngsters do not realize the dangers in this innocent pastime if certain safety rules are not obeyed, the most important of which is to never fly kites where there is a possibility of them getting tangled in electric power lines."

Other dangerous practices in connection with kite flying include using metallic cord or wire for the kite string, making the kite frame of metal, flying kites in the rain when even a cotton kite string can become a dangerous conductor of electricity and trying to retrieve a kite in case it gets caught in electric wires.

"Local youngsters who fly kites have been careful and cooperative in the past and we've had no serious mishaps in several years, but each year, over the nation, there are many cases of injuries to kite flyers," Mr. Lemons added.

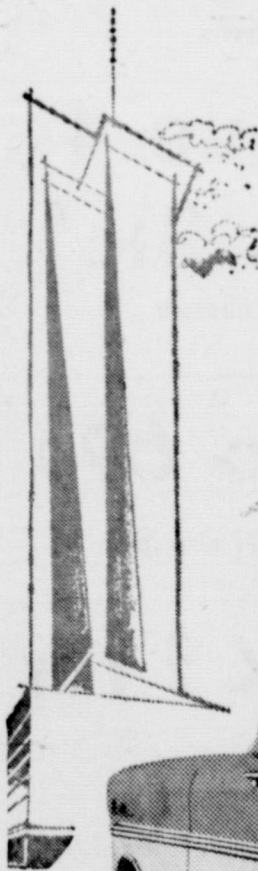
