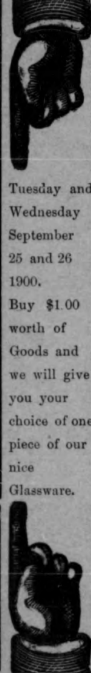

Charley Bowles fell off a trestle, or something of the kind, at the Court House Saturday and broke his left wrist.

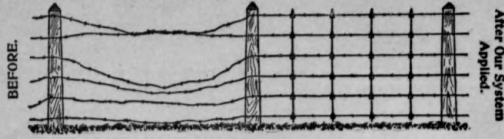

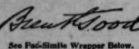
