Tribute to Pioneers

The following words of tribute were read Tuesday at the Pioneer Day assembly by Carter McGregor:

The greatness of our nation lies in the pioneer spirit of American men and women. Nowhere in our land does that spirit remain alive and vital like it does in our Southwestern-area, and particularly here in Texas and Oklahoma.

Pioneering is not limited to any time or any place. Pioneering spirit remains alive as long as men and women keep it alive. It is the spirit that says, "I do not choose to be a common man. It is my right to be uncommon, if I can." It is the spirit that seeks opportunity—not security. It is the spirit that takes the calculated risk, that dreams, builds, fails—and succeeds. It is the spirit that will not barter incentive for a dime.

The pioneering spirit lies in the hearts of men and women. When it dies there, no constitution, no law, no court can do much to help it. The spirit of pioneers is the one that will not trade freedom for a beneficence, nor individual dignity for a handout.

Today the pioneer spirit stands on a new threshold. It challenges the vast unknown of outer space—stands erect against fearsome threats and stand as a challenge to men who would be free in any place on earth. It is the heritage given us by our pioneers who are present here today.

Ships & Shells

The navy has an attractive display in the Fair auditorium. One portion is a foreign travel display. The other is a shell collection. The shells are outstanding, the art work of William F. Carter, a member of the Wichita Falls Fire department.

Also a large collection of model ships, also built by Carter.

W. F. Carter enlisted in the navy in 1940. After receiving training at San Diego, Calif., he served aboard the USS Utah which was sunk by Japanese planes during the Pearl Harbor attack.

Carter was transferred to the Atlantic where he made 14 crossings on convoy duty. He later was on a high speed transport which carried underwater demolition teams for invasions in the Pacific. He is credited with shooting down five enemy planes.

Carter was discharged in June 1946 as BM2c after six years of active duty.

The past 14 years he has been building model ships as a hobby.
