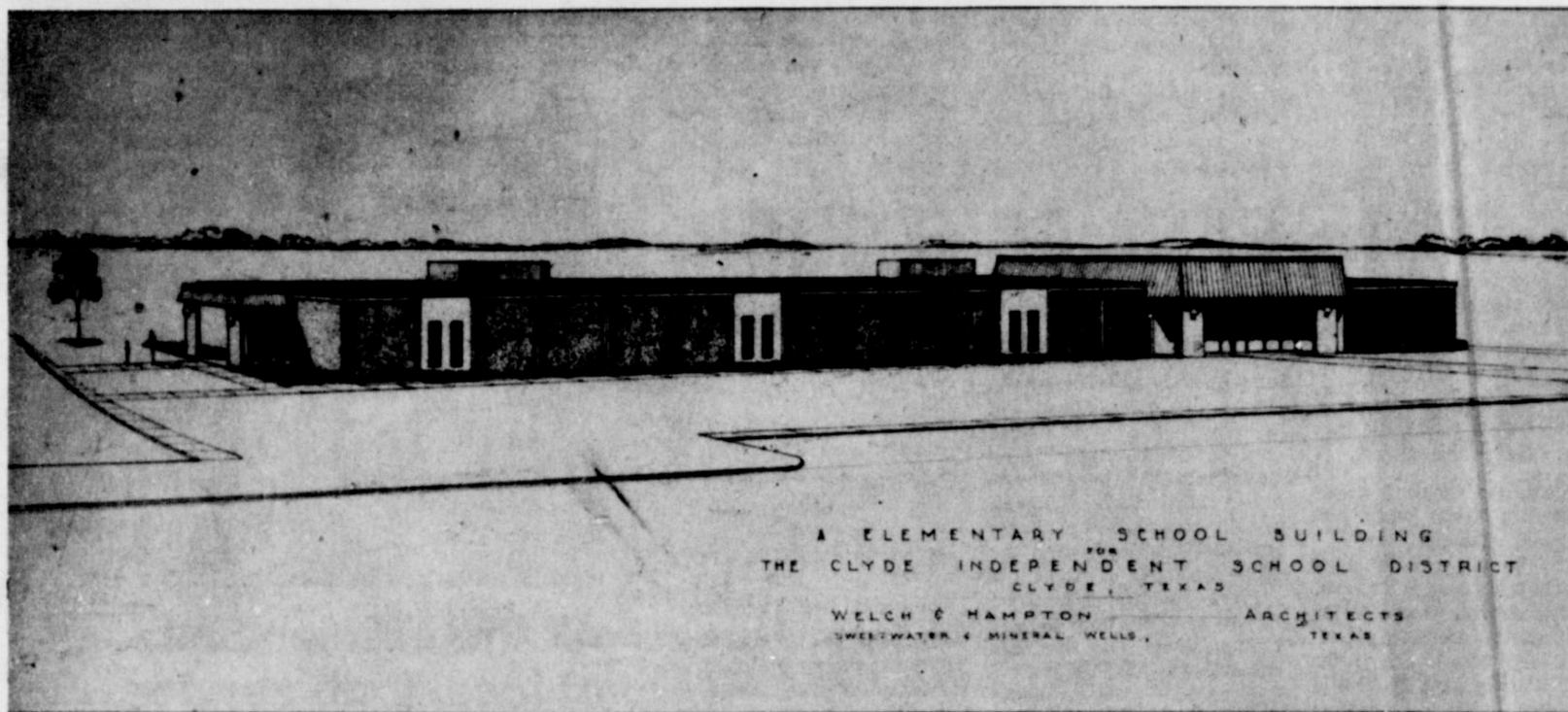

Hanner Chevrolet Co. Inc. is expected to open sometime around March 1, 1975. The new shop will have 11,000 square feet of floor, space, they have increased their parts department and added about \$15,000 in new shop equipment. The new shop will also, have five new double post hydraulic lifts, a

complete lubricating department, undercoating service center and wash. Along with the new facilities Hanner Chevrolet Co. Inc., will now employ a total of thirteen employees and anticipate to double both sales and service.

CLYDE TO GET SCHOOL BUILDINGS, REMODEL OLD

CLYDE—Voters in Clyde School District voted to accept a \$750,000 school building program by a small margin on August 31st.

The new buildings are to include a new elementary school also a new science facility, music building and library for the high school and remodeling of existing school buildings.

The new elementary building will be built on a 17.4 acre tract about 3/4 mile west of the present campus on FM 18. The elementary building will house kindergarten through grade five and hopefully will be completed by January 1976.

Our present primary and elementary classroom buildings will become a middle school for grades 6 through 8.

The building presently holding elementary and

junior high students will be used for high school classrooms.

The new science building, library and music building will be built adjacent to this building.

Sale of the \$750,000 school building bonds has been approved by the Board of

Trustees. Sales of the bonds will be completed when approved by the Attorney General and registered by the State Comptroller. Final approval will be in early January.

Final approval of plans and letting of a contract will be in the near future.

CITY OF CLYDE HAS MADE PROGRESS

CLYDE—Lots of things have been done by the City of Clyde this past year. Just a few are:

In February the Foster addition was taken into the City Limits.

A total of 54 new water taps have been made in 1974. The City has approximately 770 meters in use now.

Work is gradually being

completed at the Clyde Lake. Boat ramps have been constructed and the park area is almost complete with, barbeque grills, rest rooms, water and camping trailer connections. However the road to the lake is not completed and is the main problem right now. Paving of the road is to be done in early spring.

During the year the City purchased a dump truck, for making street repairs and hauling.

They also purchased a new GMC 1/2 ton pick up to be used in maintenance of City work.

Callahan County Farmer's Co-op Has Record Year

BAIRD—This year the Callahan County Farmers Cooperative had a record year, with sales totaling, \$1,476,752.06 and a record savings for its members of \$60,351.99 paying patronage dividends of \$12,397.41 in cash to its members. The Callahan County Farmers Co-op has 417 members this year not including their stockholders and a savings rate of approximately 4% of their 1973-74 sales.

According to Cooperative Manager Jimmy Roppolo, each members dividend is figured on the volume of purchases made by the individual for any said year.

Roppolo explained that a lot of changes have been made in the operation of the mill. The three vertical mixers which had been in use for years have been replaced by one horizontal mixer, which simplified

CALLAHAN COUNTY STAR COMPLETELY REMODELED

BAIRD—The Callahan County Star has been a point of much activity during this past year. From enlarging our office space, and remodeling it all, to new machinery on which to print the paper, and a new look about our paper.

We have enlarged our office space, taking in the small building next to us, and have remodeled both buildings and soon the front of both buildings will be repainted.

This allows us much more office space and a clean work room for the new machinery we now use to print your Callahan County Star.

The new machinery, which we have touched on briefly above, has been installed for approximately two months and is the reason for the new look about the newspaper.

The major piece of machinery we have received is the Linocomp which is a multi-purpose photo typesetter, actually a no-nonsense "photographic typewriter". This new machine produces all of our reading matter.

We have a Waxtec wax coater, a machine necessary for paste-up needs and used in off-set type productions. Copy is simply fed into the machine and the rollers automatically apply a thin film of pressure-sensitive adhesive wax. Copy then is applied to the surface desired, and pressed down flat with a pressure roller. This compact easy to operate machine can be used in any convenient location and simply plugged into a standard outlet and is ready to use.

Then we have a kodak pro-

cessor in which the film from the Linocomp is fed into, it is processed inside this machine, like your pictures are developed, and is fed out in columns on strips of paper. This paper then is clipped and set up into the columns of newsprint which you read.

And last, we have the Headliner, which makes the larger print at the top of each story.

So as you can see we have been quite busy at the Callahan County Star, working toward making a better a paper for you. We hope you like our new changes and continue to think of the Callahan County Star as YOUR paper!!!

City of Baird Working Hard For The Future

BAIRD—The City of Baird has been rather busy this year, on several projects. To start off with some of the major projects, we will talk first about the new Sanitary Landfill.

It was a great challenge, but the City of Baird has met the regulation requirements of Texas Air Control Board and the Texas Department of Health. They requested that the City discontinue outdoor burning and initiate a satisfactory disposal system, which was to provide the city dump, which would be run by the same regulations as in larger cities. The City would (in brief) have to provide landfills in three pits, one for dead animals, one for limbs, brush, etc, and one for garbag

On December 3, 1974, this new operation went into effect. Mr. Virgil Sadler will now live in a trailer home on the Landfill premises and instruct citizens where to dump their refuse. All trash, rubbish, and etc. must be put in a pit that will be dug and maintained for that purpose.

All brush will be piled in a designated place. This brush will then be run through a chipper and will become a pile of chips, or if you will pile the brush somewhere in your alley and give the city a call, the chipper is on a trailer and has a self-contained motor, so it can be brought to where it is needed, and the brush will be chipped up where it stands and given to citizens for flower beds, fire places, etc.

All the brush that is put in the pits will be compacted and covered with 6 inches of sand at the end of each day and then when the pit is completely full it will be covered with 2 feet of sand.

All the materials, except

the plastic and glass, in years to come will decompose and enrich the land.

All of this is being brought to you at an expenditure of

LOOKING BACK AT CLYDE IN YEAR '74

CLYDE—As the year rolls to an end we look back and see progress made in our City of Clyde, numerous new homes have been built in Shalimar, and in two additions south of Clyde.

Our school attendance has reached an all time high, approximately 1,020 students, and plans for the new school facilities are being made.

In late September record amounts of rain filled the Clyde Lake.

In June, Harber Grocery doubled the size of its grocery store, adding new merchandise and a fuller line of stock. Robert Harber purchased the store from Pyeatt's. The store has been in the same location for over a half a century. The Harbers are still adding to the store, making it more convenient for their customers.

Tragedy struck Clyde in February as an explosion took the lives of three Clyde Volunteer Firemen, and

later in the year another fireman was killed as a firetruck overturned.

John and Olen Holtz came to Clyde in February, purchasing Piggly Wiggly and is now called Holtz Super Market.

Oak Street in Clyde has had almost all buildings remodeled and changes made inside also, making the street very impressive.

First National Bank Baird Has Updated Entire Banking Process

BAIRD—The first part of October 1973, The First National Bank of Baird modernized all phases of its banking operations, with two Burroughs L5000 computers, and an S200 proof encoder.

The bank's basic accounting system has remained the same but the completely electronic machines have enabled them to offer their customers their services of computerized banking yet has not forced the bank to send their work out of town to be processed by another bank.

The First National Bank can now offer their customers the

speed, accuracy and volume capacity of computers, yet continue to have local control. There are no out of town processing time lags, yet the bank has retained the familiar customer ledger cards and has continued to add a personal touch to banking. "It's easier to make adjustments or change to fit the customer's needs", says Fred Goble, president, and we also have been able to continue personal checking accounts without account numbers."

What is really good from the customers standpoint, pointed out President Goble, is that the

interest is paid quarterly and a statement of customers savings is provided. Also, there is an automatic calculation of saving interest at the time of each deposit or withdrawal. The expected amount of interest is available at a glance from the customers ledger and certificates of deposits can be made for any interest or term.

Checking accounts have been handled in the same method, but in an even quicker and more efficient manner. James Eubanks, Executive Vice President

FAMILY PLANNING SERVICE OFFERED to CALLAHAN COUNTY

BAIRD—The Callahan County Advisory Board for the Central Texas Opportunity Family Planning Project met Monday, December 16th in Cross Plains. The Board members present were: Lloyd Hagemeyer, Pender Mitchell, Lorene Arledge, Ted Souder, and the Family Planning Community Health Aide, Lurene Richardson.

Family Planning in Callahan County provides the following services to the women in their childbearing years; a complete health check-up which includes; a heart and lung check, a breast exam, a pelvic exam including a pap test for cancer and a gonorrhoea smear, a urinalysis for protein and sugar, a blood pressure test and a blood test for Anemia and Syphilis.

In addition the clinic offers, also free of charge complete counseling covering all methods of birth control, causes and cures of Venereal diseases and information on problem pregnancies. Also if a woman desires a birth control method that will be offered, free of charge.

All of these services are offered, free of charge, but appointments should be made by contacting Lorene Richardson, Community Health aide for Callahan County at 817-725-7697.

\$40,000, in equipment and \$80,000 in land value.

Then in August of this year the City of Baird, after many months of planning and hours of labor installed a 40 HP water pump, which enables Baird to get its water from either the Railroad Lake or the Baird Lake. It was also necessary to replace some of the old lines and make extensive repairs to enable the water to reach the filtering plant, but once it is there the citizens can rest assured that it is as pure and wholesome as from any place around.

The cost of this new water supply is over \$4,000 for materials alone, but the council feels the expense is justified, as it will assure Baird of an ample water supply for years to come.

Also, this last year the city spent \$80,000 piping water and sewage lines and electricity to the city's newest section, The North Village. The Village now has three homes and will begin on the fourth sometime before the first of the year.

The City purchased a new Pack-a-Truck, for the regular twice a week pickups in the residential sections of the city

at a cost of \$9,000. The old garbage truck is being used to escort the chipper around town and carry off its wastes.

Then the City has a lot of plans for the future, first in the near future they hope to be able to replace the main sewer line that services the whole northside of town and takes all the wastes to the filtering plant. The line now in use is an eight inch pipe and City Manager, Bromo Bennett, says they hope to replace it with a 12 inch pipe which will carry all wastes to the filtering plant much faster.

Through the Council of Governments a Civil Engineer has been made available to us, free of charge, to work on cleaning the trees and rubbish out of the creek which runs through the park and parallel with Cherry street. If this project is completed, it should stop all the flooding and overflowing, which has occurred in recent years. If all goes as planned the creek will be cleaned out from its beginning point all the way to Baird Lake.

So, as you see the City of Baird has been hard at work to make Baird a better place to live, so let's all do our part to help keep it this way and most of all, ENJOY IT.

A new coupon book has provided the customer with instant information concerning his installment loan with the bank. The date the payment is due, payment number, and amount of the payment are

available at a glance. A coupon booklet has been issued with each new installment loan.

The Burroughs S200 proof encoder is a product of the latest in electronic technology. Both the S200 and the L5000 computers have taken a giant step for the First National Bank of Baird in meeting today's customers requirements, and tomorrow's banking changes. To sum up the operations of these new computers, they can be programmed to figure service charges, interest and add the interest to your savings account and it can print the new statements up and transfer the balance from the old ledger to the new one, it takes care of the records on checking accounts, installment loans, certificates of deposit, savings accounts, and commercial loans. The only thing the operator has to do is to verify signatures and post the amount of the checks.

Bank officials say that these new services the Bank have been brought to you at a total investment of approximately \$60,000, but that the process has been well worth it as the First National Bank of Baird, now has one of the most up-to-date banking systems in the Country at this time, and does all it's working it's own Bank.

Plains. The County also, purchased four new County dump trucks.

Most of these new developments were brought to you by the County's Revenue Sharing Funds. When these funds were received they were placed on time deposits so that they could draw interest until they were used. Then they were used in many varied ways: as road improvements, such as purchase of trucks; radio equipment for the counties law enforcement agencies; money spent for the renovation of the Court House, environmental protection, health care for aged and indigent, community recreation facilities, assistance for the County libraries, and other multi-purpose and general government expenditures.

The funds are figured according to the tax structure and populations and how many persons dwell in the

County. The present Revenue Sharing bill is due to end in 1975, unless it is renewed by Congress. It is expected to be renewed with possibly some changes. For instance this year Callahan County received \$86,815.00 and this year we will receive only \$74,110 approximately \$12,000 less.

County officials would like to add that because of the revenue sharing program they have not even had to consider an increase in County Taxes.

For the first time now, in the County's history we have six highway patrolmen in the County, four in Baird, two in Cross Plains, a game warden in Baird and Liscense and Weights man in Clyde.

Callahan County received \$153,000 this year in Justice of the Peace Court, these fines were mostly from Interstate 20, and \$60,000 in County fines, DWI's and cases tried here in court. In all, many changes have taken place in Callahan County during the past year.

The operation of the mill enormously by cutting down dust and labor, and by having the feed already mixed and waiting when the trucks arrived. He stated that it also saved much time and was much easier to repair, than the old mixers. He noted that even though the costs of the improvements ran into the area of \$90,000, at the time of the decision, both he and the directors felt that the decision was justified.

Roppolo also draws attention to the fact that at a time when most companies were running short on fertilizer the co-op members have probably been better supplied than people in most areas of the country. And an added attraction is the two new fertilizer trucks, which do a terrific job of spreading fertilizer.

During this past year the Co-op also, worked with area high schools in sending six students to The Farmland Industries Co-op Youth Leadership Conference in Kansas City. There they learned how a Cooperative is organized and run and some of the cooperative principals.

This Callahan County Farmers Cooperative, it's Board of Directors, and employees wish to take this opportunity to thank each and every patron for their support and business in helping to make 1973-74 their best year.
