VOTERS KEEP BEER HERE BY 28 VOTES IN CLOSE ELECTION

Cross Plains And Dressy Go Wet And Caddo Peak Dry; 454 Votes Are Tabulated

By the narrow margin of 28 votes beer sales will remain legal in Cross Plains, as a result of a precinct election Saturday. The total vote was 241 wet and 213 dry.

Largest margin for beer was polled at Cross Plains, where the wets tallied 201 and the dries 163. The Dressy box was wet by four votes—32 to 28. Caddo Peak was dry by 14 votes—22 to eight.
