## Lynx Skin Wildcats

### On To Regionals

On Friday afternoon, at a Spearman school wide pep rally, Dr. Scott Martin challenged the Spearman Lynx with the question, "Are the Lynx for real?" Friday night in Canyon, this scrapping team demonstrated how real they really were.

The Lynx faced a competent, undefeated Idalou Wildcat team, but they dug deep and brought home the Area Championship trophy. Early in the third quarter, the Wildcats took the lead and appeared to begin controlling the game, but the Lynx, with the courage and determination that they have demonstrated all season rallied for the come from behind 24-14 victory. This brings the lynx

season record to 11-1.

A very strong effort on the part of the Lynx defense held the Wildcats to only 106 rushing yards and caused the Idalou team to turn the ball over 5 times. Eric Cudd, Eric Varnon and Clint Goodman all made interceptions for the Lynx.

Statistically, it was a very close game with both teams having 14 first downs and 287 total yards for Spearman and 261 total yards for Idalou. Although the Wildcats had a strong passing game with 155 yards (82 yards on two plays), they were no match for the Lynx defense.

Jack Howard scored first for the Lynx with a 6 yard run. Britt Savage kicked a 27 yard field

goal. Howard scored again with a 1 yard run. Michael Witten carried the ball 28 yards for the Lynx final touchdown.

Blake Beedy and Clint Goodman were named the defensive players of the week and Michael Witten was named the offensive player of the week. Beedy had 15 assisted tackles and 3 unassisted tackles. Goodman had 5 assisted tackles and 2 unassisted tackles. Witten carried the ball 26 times for 176 yards.

Frankie Dominguez, Eric Cudd and Eric Varnon all recovered fumbles for the Lynx team.

Said Coach Ric Smith, "This Lynx team has done a great job.

They have shown a lot of heart and there is no quit in them."

Concerning the regional game, Smith commented, "The game against Iraan is going to be a tough one. They are similar to Idalou. They throw the ball more than Idalou and we are going to have to be able to stop both the running and passing game."

This victory takes the Lynx to the regional playoffs. The game is scheduled for 7:30, Friday night at Lowry Field in Lubbock against Iraan.

## Spearman Elementary Honored

Spearman Elementary was recently honored with a four star rating in the November issue of the Texas Monthly magazine.

Spearman was compared to 3,172 elementary schools in Texas. The rating system was based on the Texas Assessment of Academic Skills (TAAS) test, the one consistent, uniform statewide measure of what students are learning. Several hundred schools were excluded from the ratings because they tested fewer than fifty students or contained only one or two grades and thus did not meet the Texas Education Agency's definition of an elementary school. TAAS Scores alone do not tell much about how good a job a school is doing. To compare a suburban school with an inner-city school, even in the same area, is to compare apples and oranges. A good rating system has to compare a school with others whose students have similar characteristics.

This rating system, developed by Darvin M. Winick of the

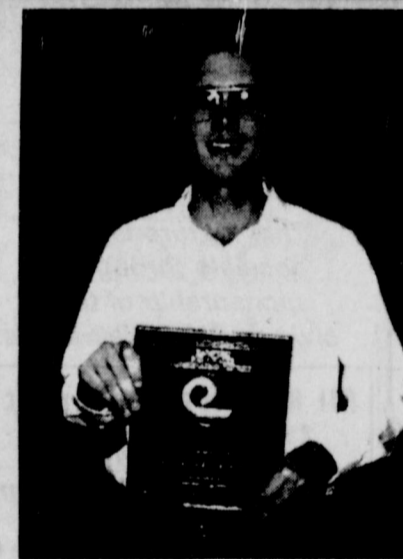
Center for Houston's Future (an affiliate of the Greater Houston Partnership) and Larry Toenjes, a University of Houston sociologist, is based on two numbers - the percentage of children who passed all sections of the TAAS test and the percentage of kids on the free-or-assisted-lunch program.

The rating system assigns stars for meeting certain goals. The best schools in Texas earned four stars; the worst, none. These are the requirements for earning a star:

- One star if at least 30 percent of the students passed the TAAS test.
- A second star if the school ranked at or above the median passing rate on the TAAS test for schools with a similar percentage of disadvantaged students.
- A third star if at least 70 percent of the students passed the TAAS test.
- A fourth star if the school had a passing rate on the TAAS test in the top 15 percent of schools with a similar percentage of disadvantaged students.

## Nursery To Plant Conservation In Hansford County

A West Texas nursery is planting conservation in Hansford County and throughout two-thirds of the state, while also lending a helping hand to High Plains producers. For the last 18 years the Texas

Forest Service (TFS) West Texas Nursery (WTN) has grown windbreak seedlings, evergreen and deciduous trees and shrubs, for landowners from the coast of Corpus Christi to Texline in the Panhandle. The WTN's primary

objective is to produce and sell quality seedlings at a price that landowners can afford, enabling them to plant large quantities of trees to establish multiple row windbreaks.

Windbreaks are trees and shrubs systematically planted adjacent to fields, homesteads, or feedlots as a barrier to reduce or redirect the wind. They create permanent, natural protection and habitat for wildlife, reduce erosion and increase permanent, natural protection and habitat for wildlife, reduce erosion and increase land value and aesthetics.

Annually, WTN grows approximately 200,000 evergreens of eight different species in its two irrigated greenhouses and about 400,000 bare-root seedlings in its eight-acre field nursery. The trees are grown from seed collected by nursery staff.

Each year the seedlings are sold and delivered through Hansford Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) and over 90 other SWCDs around the state. The date of delivery, beginning in February, is dependent on the planting season within the delivery region.

But the WTN's service does not halt at production. Nursery staff members also assist High Plains producers by taking conservation from the greenhouse to the field. Upon the request of a High Plains landowner, the TFS WTN will meet with the landowner, discuss the protection needs and design a windbreak plan according to those needs. Landowners willing to follow the guidelines listed within their plan are then personally assisted by the TFS in planting the windbreak. (Qualifying landowners must own at least 160 acres.)

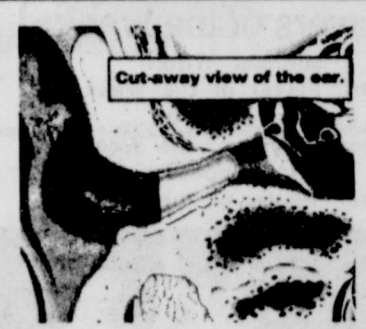
The TFS supplies a tree planter, which plants 400 to 500 seedlings per hour, and a fabric layer, rolling out a UV synthetic fabric over the seedlings. The fabric conserves moisture and reduces weeds.

The TFS assists in planting field, livestock, homestead and wildlife windbreaks and living

snow fences. In 1995 the TFS assisted high Plains landowners in planting 14 miles of windbreaks.

Producers, be it the farmer or rancher, interested in windbreak protection can begin ordering seedlings this fall for the 1997 planting season through the Hansford SWCD.

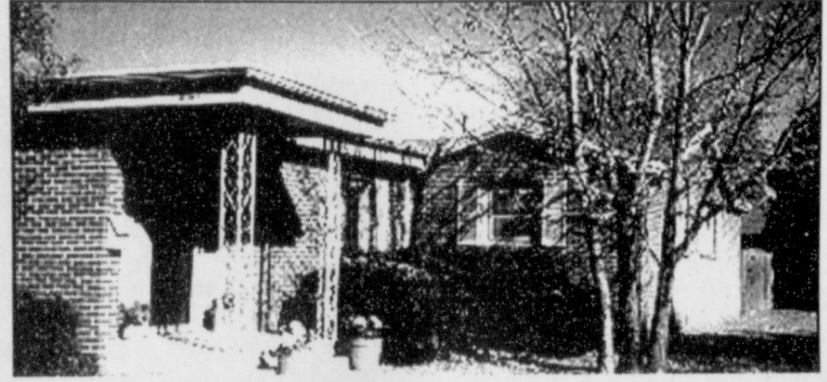

## NEWS FROM THE POST OFFICE

**by George Finley, Postmaster**  
With Christmas time around the corner there are a few tips we need to inform you of so you can get your mail where it needs to be.

When you mail a package, address it with a dark marker in big letters.

Put plenty of padding around your contents. We prefer at least 4 inches. Your package goes into a sack with others and yours may be on the bottom.

Do not use masking tape. Strapping tape is the best, or duct tape may also be used. Masking tape will many times come loose

in transport. Put your name and address inside the package with the contents. If the worst happens and for some reason your package gets torn where you can't read the address, yours will still be on the inside.

Please don't use mailing labels. Most of these are good while they are wet. We have seen them get dry, wrinkle up and pop of the package. Not just with packages, but with all your mail.

Make sure you use the correct mailing address. Sometimes the house address is not the same as the mailing address. I know your thinking, I've lived here for 50 years. Everyone in town knows me. This may be true, but there may be a new employee in the

Post Office that has never seen you.

We also want you to do something else for us. If you have been using another company to mail your packages, I want you to do me a favor. Next time you go there get the price that they are going to charge. Tell them thank you and bring that same package to the Post Office, and compare prices. If it will save you money, isn't it worth a little extra time to compare. You do with other things. We want to do what we can to help you, please come by and give us a chance.

Again, don't forget to mail early. Also, have a very good Thanksgiving, and remember why we celebrate it.
