News digest Navy gives computer contract to Texas firm WASHINGTON - In a bold move to privatize its computer services hackers, the Navy awarded a conTract potentially worth $\$ 9$ billion to a separate Navy and Marine Corps
computer networks into seamless system.
The contract, awarded Friday to Electronic Data Systems Corp. of
Plano, Texas, is the largest-of its kind ever issued by the government
Navy Secretary Richard Danzig said. This marks the first time in the computer age that a branch of the military has turned over to a private
company the responsibility and risk company the responsibility and risk
of operating and maintaining its entire network of computer systems. The new information system, known as an intranet, is seen by the
Defense Department - whose thousands of computer networks are the largest and most far-flung in the world - as a model for the military as a whole.

The new system is expected to be
fully operational by June 2003 . The contract is for a guaranteed minimum of $\$ 4.1$ billion over five years, although Danzig said that
probably will be about $\$ 6$ billion. The Navy can extend the contract for another three years for a minimum of $\$ 2.8$ billion. The winning bid was lar trading on the New York Stock

Connecticut who called his role a miracle and seems to be thriving in it.
Cheney was the safe choice, the rumning
mate Bush's people said he picked because he mate Bush's people said he picked becanue he
was more concerned about governing than was more concerned about governing than
about campaigning, But candidates do not get about campaigning, But candidates do not get
to the former without the latter, and Cheney has proved a routine campaigner at best. He was thrown off stride from the start by
questions about his votes against popular ino questions about his votes against popular pro-
grams as a conservative congressman fiom grams as a conservative congressman from
Wyoming. Next came criticism of his big money retirement deal with the oil supply corporation he had headed, and the question of whether
he would forgo millions of dollars worth of he would forgo millions of dollars worth of

He finally stid he would forfeit the options. Then he was dogged by questions about skimpy donations to charity and about not offices or issues, in the five years he had lived Lieberman came to the ticket with his own set of problems, but managed to duck or talk his way around them. Clinton in the Monica Lewinsky scandal that led to his impeachment. While Lieberman scolded the president in a Senate speech in 1998, he voted in 1999 against convicting Clinton of the impeachment charges.

Even those who have Mary Martin's acelaimed performance emblazoned in their memories will likely be won over by Rigby. Rigby's Peter Pan is, not surprisingly, extremely athletic.

And despite these somewhat precious touches, this musical does not talk down to those old enough to remember Rigby garnering 12 medals in international gymnastics competitions.
The incomparable Jerome Robbins did the original Broadway choreography. and Patti Colombo changed it for this rendition. The result is terrific, particularly when Dana Solimando takes the stage as Tiger Lity. The other breakout performance is Paul Schoeffler, who's a wonderful, scurvy Capt. Hook. And John lacovelli's sets, particularly the Darling children's Victorian nursery, are exquisite.
"The James Barrie novel is so rich, and it is as much the psychological side as much as it is the light and wonderful flying and fun and adventure," Rigby says. "We tried to add more of a contrast and you saw more of the character. Hook was funny and a bad guy. Neverland is a wonderful place to visit and also very dangerous. If you add those colors to it, it is richer and more fun to watch and you also get to see the different aspects of Peter. He has everything a child could want. He flies and he has a band of lost boys and they play and they build homes underground. But everybody leaves him and he doesn't have the very thing he longs for -a mother and a father and a family."
